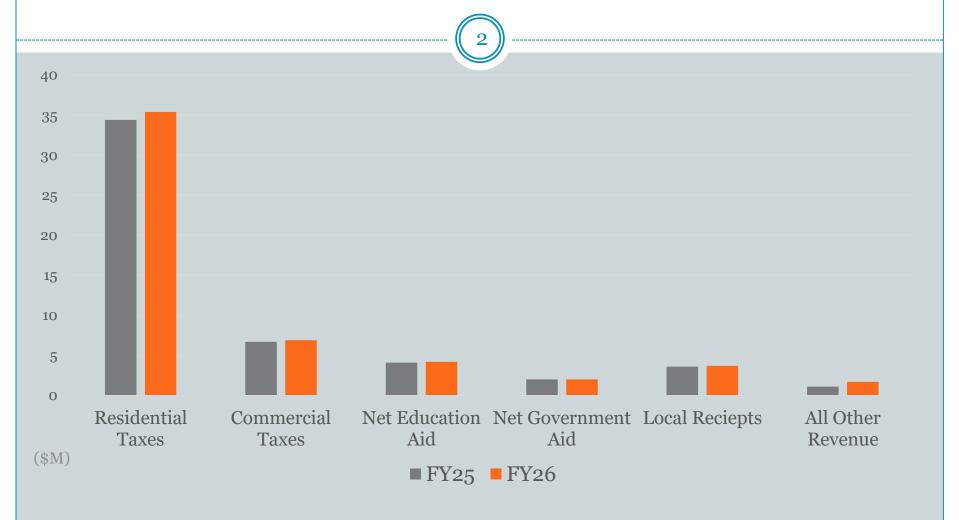

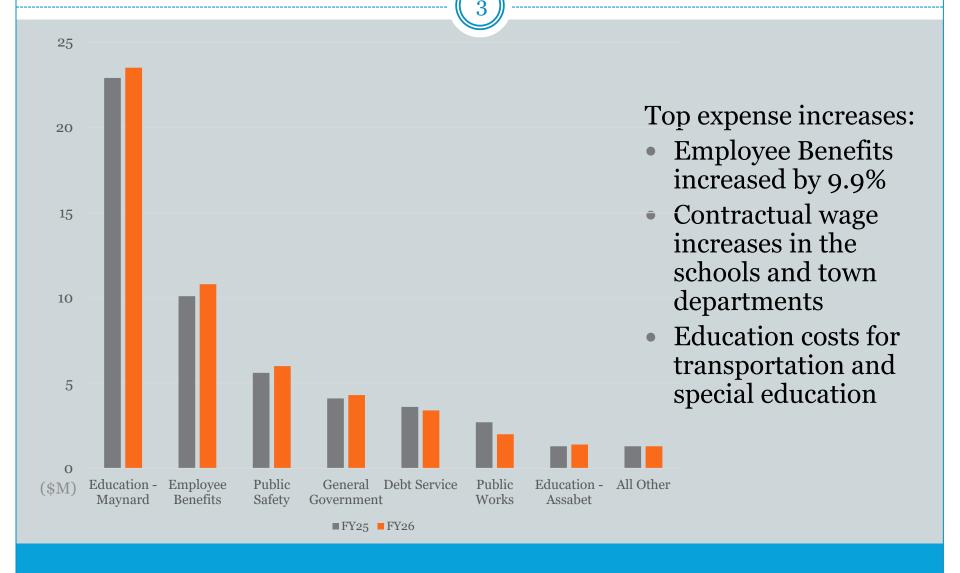
FISCAL YEAR 2026 (FY26) Budget Overview

Revenue Forecast

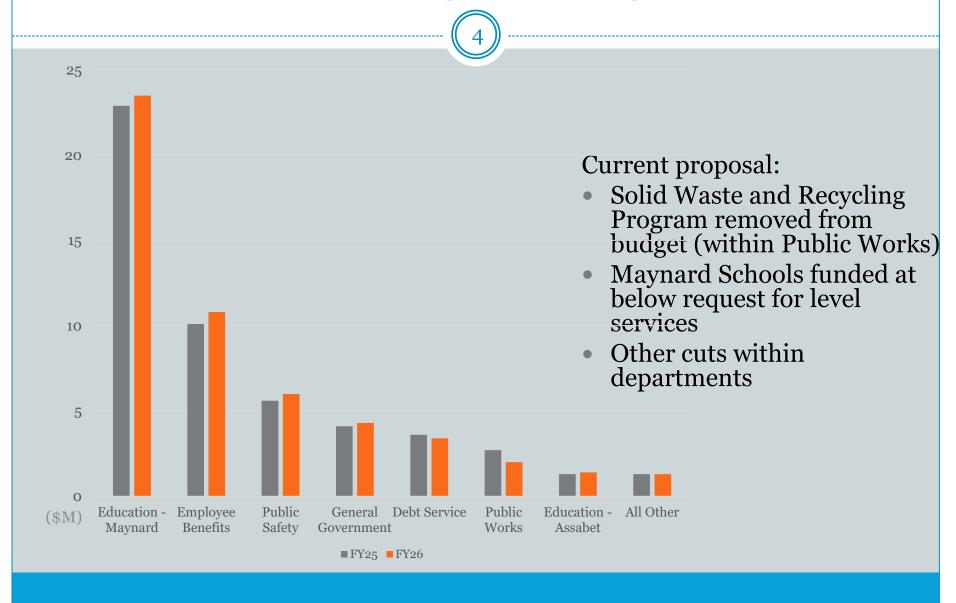


• Revenue is increasing slowly, at about 4.1%

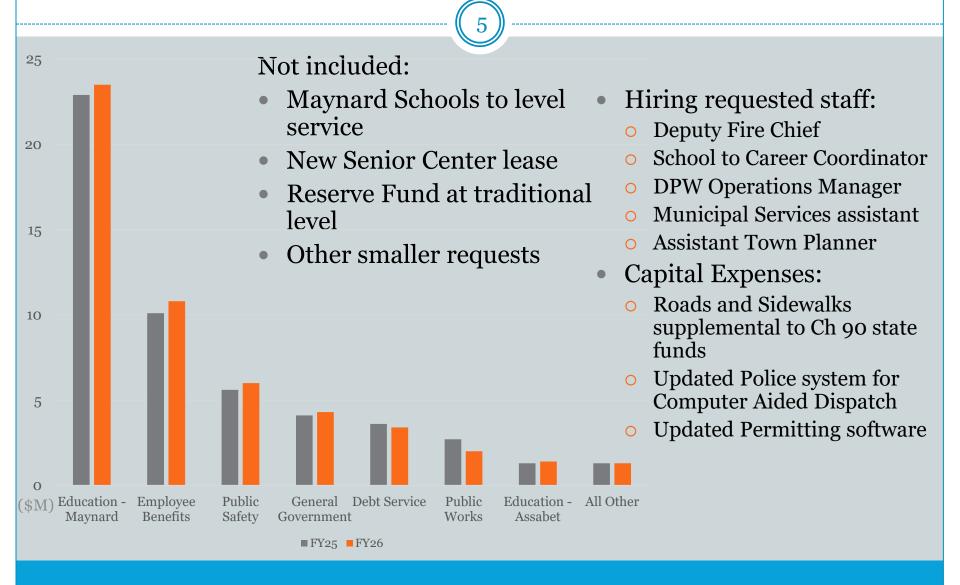
Expenses

Select Board Considerations

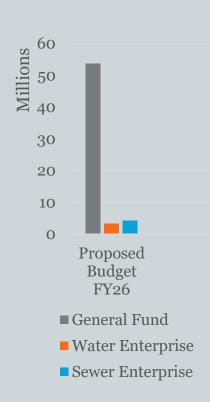


- The Select Board is proposing
 - \$200k override for a new Senior Center lease
 - Using stabilization funds and free cash to maintain solid waste and recycling program
- The Select Board is considering
 - o Changing the benefits plan offered to Maynard employees
 - An override of up to \$1.2M to meet the school's level service request
- Every \$100k of override would increase the average single household tax bill annually by ~\$25
 - \$200k Senior Center ~ \$50
 - \$1.2M School funding ~\$300

Water/Sewer



- Separate from taxes: Billed as utilities to "customers"
- Investing in phases for water sources and treatment:
 - New Well 4A Well and Treatment
 - Expanded Rockland Avenue Well and Treatment
 - Expanded Old Marlborough Road Well and Treatment
 - Advocacy for access to state water supply
- The Select Board is considering rebates for household filters, and impact to budget and rates



Capital



- Free Cash: unable to be projected each year
 - o Supporting Solid Waste/Recycling:
 - ▼ Direct allocation of Free Cash
 - Transfer from General Stabilization ("rainy day fund")
 - Projected revenue from sticker sales
 - o Snow/Ice
 - o DPW Facility Replacement Designs and Project Management
 - Library Stairwell
 - Police Cruiser
 - o DPW Truck
 - Capital Stabilization and OPEB deposits
